Facts about Dubai

- Dubai is the most populous city and one of the 7 emirates in the United Arab Emirates(UAE)
- Dubai is the second largest emirate by territorial size after the capital, Abu Dhabi.
- Dubai is a global city and aviation hub.
- Travel Time from India : 3 hour 15 minutes by flight .
- Currency : UAE Dirham (1 Dirham = 20 INR).

Why we should suggest students to go for higher studies to Dubai ?

- Attracting different nationalities.
- Value for money.
- Shorter & more intensive courses.
- Popular destination for Indian students.
- UK, Australia and USA Universities have their campuses in Dubai.
- Student can take transfer to the parent campus after finishing one academic year of their UG Course based on their scores.



Why we should suggest students to go for higher studies to Dubai ?

- Dubai Education is affordable.
- Age limit is not a problem in regard to student visa. If the student is meeting academic entry requirement he can apply irrespective of his age, let him be 18 yrs or 50 yrs.
- Gap in the studies is also not an issue.
- Options without IELTS also available.
- Duration of Bachelor's is 3 years or 4 years and Master's duration is 1 or 2 year.



Why we should suggest students to go for higher studies to Dubai ?

- Post Graduate students can legally change their student visa to work visa in case if they find an employer. The same student can continue his studies as a part time student. The classes will be from 6 PM to 9 PM or on weekends (depending upon University).
- A student needs to shell out between 3000 AED to 4000 AED (INR 54000-70000) per month for the living expenses.
- IELTS of 6.5* required for PG courses and 6.0* required for UG Courses.

* - IELTS waiver if student scored more than 70% in 12th English. MBA Courses are the exceptions in that.



Intakes

Dubai Universities have two major intakes

- **September**
- **January**

Note: University of Wollongong, Canadian University and Murdoch University also has May intake along with January and September.
